Summary (as of Dec 7, 2009)

Brucella Abortus Removal Act of 2009 - Prohibits either the list of biological agents and toxins that have the potential to pose a severe threat to public health and safety established under the Public Health Service Act or the list of biological agents and toxins that have the potential to pose a severe threat to animal or plant health or to animal or plant products established under the Agricultural Bioterrorism Protection Act of 2002 from including brucella abortus.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 29, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Horticulture and Organic Agriculture.
- **Dec 8, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 7, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 7, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
