Summary (as of Dec 9, 2009)

Amends the Small Business Act to consider an individual with a net worth of less than \$978,722 as eligible for participation in a Small Business Administration (SBA) program providing grants to small businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals.

Requires such amount to be adjusted annually for inflation.
