Summary (as of Jan 19, 2010)

Military Tribunals for Terrorists Act of 2010 - Requires trial only by a military commission for any foreign national who: (1) engages or has engaged in an offense relating to a terrorist attack against persons or property in the United States or U.S. government property or personnel outside the United States; and (2) is subject to trial for that offense by a military commission under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 1, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties.
- **Jan 21, 2010:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H270)
- **Jan 19, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 19, 2010:** Referred to House Armed Services
- **Jan 19, 2010:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jan 19, 2010:** Referred to House Judiciary
