Summary (as of May 18, 2009)

Waives a specified requirement of Rule XIII (Calendar and Committee Reports) to allow consideration of S. 896 (Helping Families Save Their Homes Act of 2009) on the same day it is presented to the House.

Actions Timeline

- **May 20, 2009:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 456, H. Res. 450 is laid on the table. (consideration: CR H5808, H5822)
- **May 18, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **May 18, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-113, by Mr. Perlmutter.
- **May 18, 2009:** The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions reported from the Rules Committee. The rule applies the waiver to any resolution reported on the legislative day of May 19, 2009, providing for consideration or disposition of S. 896, a bill to prevent mortgage foreclosures and enhance mortgage credit availability.
- **May 18, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 54.
