Summary (as of Feb 2, 2010)

GI Bill Enhancement Act of 2010 - Increases from \$19 million to \$24 million the annual amount available to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs (VA) to reimburse state agencies for expenses incurred in approving courses of education for participation in the veterans' educational assistance program.

Directs the Secretary, for each fiscal year, to adjust such amount to account for changes in the cost of living.
