- **Jun 3, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 231 - 174 (Roll no. 295).(text: CR H6099)
- **Jun 3, 2009:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 231 - 174 (Roll no. 295). (text: CR H6099)
- **Jun 3, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 2, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 2, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-131, by Mr. Cardoza.
- **Jun 2, 2009:** General debate for both bills is limited to 1 hour equally divided and controlled. For H.R. 1385, specified amendments are in order. For each bill, the previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
- **Jun 2, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 61.
