Summary (as of Apr 22, 2010)

Helping Save Americans' Health Care Choices Act of 2010 - Repeals provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) providing for: (1) an increased penalty for distributions from a health savings account or Archer medical savings account not used for qualified medical expenses; (2) a restriction of payments from health savings accounts, Archer medical savings accounts, and health flexible spending arrangements for medications to prescription drugs or insulin; and (3) a \$2,500 limitation on annual salary reduction contributions to health flexible spending arrangements under cafeteria plans.

Amends PPACA to treat a high deductible health plan as a qualified health plan for purposes of such Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 22, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 22, 2010:** Referred to House Ways and Means
- **Apr 22, 2010:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Apr 22, 2010:** Referred to House Energy and Commerce
