Summary (as of Apr 29, 2010)

Fair Health Care for Military Families Act - Increases to 26 the maximum age for certain children eligible for medical care under: (1) the Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Department of Veterans Affairs (CHAMPVA); and (2) TRICARE (a Department of Defense [DOD] managed health care program).

Actions Timeline

- **May 6, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Apr 30, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Apr 29, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 29, 2010:** Referred to House Armed Services
- **Apr 29, 2010:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Apr 29, 2010:** Referred to House Veterans' Affairs
