Authorizes appropriations for FY2010-2012 for the National Clearinghouse for Long-Term Care Information.

- **Jan 14, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jan 14, 2009:** Referred to House Energy and Commerce
