Summary (as of May 5, 2010)

Improving Veterans' Electronic Transition Services Act or the iVETS Act - Directs the Secretaries of Defense (DOD) and Veterans Affairs (VA) to jointly: (1) develop and implement a system allowing a veteran to securely and electronically access his or her military personnel file; (2) conduct a study on establishing a veterans portal based on the knowledge online portals; and (3) report study results to the congressional defense and veterans committees.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 18, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **May 5, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **May 5, 2010:** Referred to House Armed Services
- **May 5, 2010:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **May 5, 2010:** Referred to House Veterans' Affairs
