- **Jan 13, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 13, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-2, by Mr. McGovern.
- **Jan 13, 2009:** The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill except those arising under clause 9 of rule XXI. The resolution provides that the Committee of the Whole shall rise without motion after general debate and that no further consideration of the bill shall occur except pursuant to a subsequent order of the House.
- **Jan 13, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 2.
