America COMPETES Reauthorization Act of 2010 - Establishes, revises, and extends specified science, technology, education, and mathematics (STEM) programs (including in green energy education), as well as engineering, research, and training programs, and establishes a green chemistry basic research program and a green manufacturing and construction initiative.

Authorizes appropriations for FY2011-FY2013 for: (1) the National Science Foundation (NSF); (2) the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST); and (3) the Department of Energy (DOE) for activities of the Office of Science.

- **May 19, 2010:** Mr. Gordon (TN) moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **May 19, 2010:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H3548-3583; text of measure as introduced: CR H3549-3578)
- **May 19, 2010:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 5325.
- **May 19, 2010:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
- **May 19, 2010:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H3594)
- **May 19, 2010:** Failed of passage/not agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Failed by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 261 - 148 (Roll no. 277).
- **May 19, 2010:** On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Failed by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 261 - 148 (Roll no. 277).
