Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2847) making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, and Science, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 16, 2009:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H6854-6862)
- **Jun 16, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 544.
- **Jun 16, 2009:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 544, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 545 and announced the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Lincoln Diaz-Balart demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 544 until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 16, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H6863-6864)
- **Jun 16, 2009:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 247 - 176 (Roll no. 346). (consideration: CR H6864)
- **Jun 16, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 247 - 174 (Roll no. 347).(text: CR H6854-6855)
- **Jun 16, 2009:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 247 - 174 (Roll no. 347). (text: CR H6854-6855)
- **Jun 16, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 15, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-155, by Mr. Arcuri.
- **Jun 15, 2009:** The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. Points of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived.
- **Jun 15, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 72.
