Summary (as of Jun 10, 2010)

Nuclear Used Fuel Prize Act of 2010 - Instructs the Secretary of Energy to implement a program to award cash prizes competitively for research, development, demonstration, and commercial application of nuclear used fuel storage.

Authorizes the Secretary to enter into an agreement with a private, nonprofit entity to administer the prize competition.
