Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2918) making appropriations for the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 19, 2009:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H7027-7033)
- **Jun 19, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 559.
- **Jun 19, 2009:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 559, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question, and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Ms. Foxx demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 19, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H7039-7040)
- **Jun 19, 2009:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 230 - 177 (Roll no. 409). (consideration: CR H7040)
- **Jun 19, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 226 - 179 (Roll no. 410).(text: CR H7027)
- **Jun 19, 2009:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 226 - 179 (Roll no. 410). (text: CR H7027)
- **Jun 19, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 18, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 18, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-161, by Mr. Hastings (FL).
- **Jun 18, 2009:** The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The resolution waives all points of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI. The resolution also provides that it shall be in order, any rule of the House to the contrary notwithstanding, to consider concurrent resolutions providing for the adjournment of the House and Senate during the month of July.
- **Jun 18, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 76.
