Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2454) to create clean energy jobs, achieve energy independence, reduce global warming pollution and transition to a clean energy economy.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-185, by Ms. Matsui.
- **Jun 26, 2009:** In lieu of the amendment recommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 2998, modified by an amendment printed in part A of this report shall be considered as adopted.
- **Jun 26, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 82.
- **Jun 26, 2009:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H7451-7461)
- **Jun 26, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 587.
- **Jun 26, 2009:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 587, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that the ayes prevailed. Mr. Sessions demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 587 until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 26, 2009:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H7462-7463)
- **Jun 26, 2009:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 232 - 189 (Roll no. 465). (consideration: CR H7462)
