Summary (as of Jul 29, 2010)

Passport Acquisition Savings and Security Act of 2010 or the PASS Act of 2010 - Provides for the payment of passport fees directly to the Department of State rather than to the U.S. Treasury.

Expresses the sense of Congress that new revenues directed to the Department should be used to reduce passport costs for consumers.
