Summary (as of Aug 5, 2010)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Box Elder Utah Land Conveyance Act - Directs the Secretary of Agriculture to convey to the town of Mantua, Utah, all interest of the United States in and to parcels of National Forest System land in the Wasatch-Cache National Forest in Box Elder County, Utah, that are labeled as parcels A, B, and C on the map entitled "Box Elder Utah Land Conveyance Act" and dated July 14, 2008.

Requires the town to use the land conveyed under this Act for public purposes.

- **Feb 24, 2009:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
- **Feb 23, 2009:** Ms. Bordallo moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Feb 23, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1626-1627)
- **Feb 23, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 601.
- **Feb 23, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
