Summary (as of Sep 29, 2010)

Social Security Safety Dividend Act - Directs the Secretary of the Treasury to disburse a \$250 payment for a particular year to recipients of Social Security benefits, Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits (under title XVI of the Social Security Act), railroad retirement benefits, or veterans disability compensation or pension benefits if no cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) is payable for any month in such a year.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2010:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **Sep 29, 2010:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2010:** Referred to House Ways and Means
- **Sep 29, 2010:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Sep 29, 2010:** Referred to House Transportation and Infrastructure
- **Sep 29, 2010:** Referred to House Veterans' Affairs
