Carolinas Revolutionary Road National Heritage Area Act - Establishes the Carolinas Revolutionary Road National Heritage Area in North Carolina and South Carolina.

Designates the Cultural and Heritage Museums of York County, South Carolina, as the local coordinating entity for the Heritage Area.

Requires the Cultural and Heritage Museums to submit a management plan for the Heritage Area.
