Summary (as of Jan 26, 2009)

COBRA Coverage Extension Act of 2009 - Extends COBRA coverage (health insurance continuation benefits) that would currently end before the 12-month period following enactment of this Act because of the 18-month coverage limitation to the earlier of: (1) the end of the 12 calendar months following the date of enactment of this Act; or (2) 24 months after the date of the qualifying event.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 27, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 26, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 26, 2009:** Referred to House Education and Labor
- **Jan 26, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jan 26, 2009:** Referred to House Energy and Commerce
- **Jan 26, 2009:** Referred to House Ways and Means
