The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Financial Services now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. All points of order against provisions of the bill, as amended, are waived.
- **Jul 30, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 100.
