- **Oct 28, 2009:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 111-317, by Ms. Pingree (ME).
- **Oct 28, 2009:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The amendment printed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of further amendment. The Chair may entertain a motion that the Committee rise only if offered by the chair of the Committee on Small Business or her designee. The Chair may not entertain a motion to strike out the enacting words of the bill. It shall be in order at any time through the legislative day of October 30, 2009, for the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules relating to a measure addressing unemployment compensation.
- **Oct 28, 2009:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 124.
