- **Nov 5, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Nov 4, 2009:** Mr. Bishop (NY) moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Nov 4, 2009:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H12332-12334)
- **Nov 4, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 878.
- **Nov 4, 2009:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Bishop (NY) objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
