Summary (as of Feb 4, 2009)

Requires the President to designate not less than three closed military installations (or portions of them) that are appropriate for siting a refinery for gasoline or other fuel.

Designates the Department of Energy as the lead agency for coordinating applicable federal refinery authorizations and related environmental reviews with respect to a designated refinery.

Gives the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia exclusive jurisdiction over civil actions relating to federal refinery authorizations.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 9, 2009:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Environment.
- **Feb 4, 2009:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 4, 2009:** Referred to House Energy and Commerce
- **Feb 4, 2009:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Feb 4, 2009:** Referred to House Armed Services
