### Summary (as of Apr 28, 2009)

Amends the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 to authorize the President to use specified funds for assistance to Pakistan upon a determination that to do so is in U.S. national security interests.

Terminates authority under this Act on September 30, 2010.
