Sets forth the rule for consideration of the conference report to accompany the bill (H.R. 3288) making appropriations for the Departments of Transportation and Housing and Urban Development, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 10, 2009:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. McGovern called up H.Res. 961 and asked for its immediate consideration.
- **Dec 10, 2009:** POINT OF ORDER - Mr. Flake raised a point of order against the provisions of H.Res. 961 on the grounds that it violated the Congressional Budget Act. The Chair announced that the disposition of the point of order would be resolved by the question of consideration of H.Res. 961. The House proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the point of order at the end of which the Chair will put the question on consideration.
- **Dec 10, 2009:** On question of consideration of the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.
- **Dec 10, 2009:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H14450-14461)
- **Dec 10, 2009:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 961.
- **Dec 10, 2009:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 227 - 187 (Roll no. 947). (consideration: CR H14460-14461)
- **Dec 10, 2009:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 221 - 200 (Roll no. 948).(text: CR H14450)
- **Dec 10, 2009:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 221 - 200 (Roll no. 948). (text: CR H14450)
- **Dec 10, 2009:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Dec 9, 2009:** Introduced in House
