Reaffirms the strong relationship between the United States and Ukraine and encourages continued efforts to implement the United States-Ukraine Charter on Strategic Partnership.

Expresses support for the Ukrainian people's efforts to consolidate democratic institutions and economic reforms.

Supports international financial institution measures to assist Ukraine.

Urges the government of Ukraine and all political parties to ensure that the 2010 election is conducted freely.
