Combat Act - Increases, as of the beginning of FY2011, the maximum monthly rates of: (1) hostile fire or imminent danger pay from \$225 to \$260; (2) hazardous duty pay from \$250 to \$260; and (3) the monthly family separation allowance from \$250 to \$285.
