Summary (as of Mar 17, 2011)

Emergency Mortgage Relief and Neighborhood Stabilization Programs Cost Recoupment Act of 2011 - Amends the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act to direct the Secretary of the Treasury, in order to offset the costs of assistance under the Emergency Mortgage Relief and Neighborhood Stabilization Programs, to make risk-based assessments in the total amount of \$2.5 billion on financial companies: (1) that manage hedge funds with \$10 billion or more in assets under management on a consolidated basis; or (2) with \$50 billion or more in total consolidated assets.
