Summary (as of Apr 1, 2011)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Government Shutdown Prevention Act of 2011 - Enacts into law the provisions of H.R. 1 (Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011), as passed by the House on February 19, 2011, if the House has not received a message from the Senate before April 6, 2011, stating that it has passed a measure providing for the appropriations for the federal departments and agencies for the remainder of FY2011.

Prohibits the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Administrative Officer of the House, respectively, from disbursing to each Member or Delegate the amount of his or her salary for each day that: (1) there is more than a 24-hour lapse in appropriations for any federal agency or department for failure to enact a regular appropriations bill or continuing resolution, or (2) the federal government is unable to make payments or meet obligations because the public debt limit has been reached.

Imposes the same restrictions on the President with respect to receiving a disbursement of basic pay during such period.

- **Apr 1, 2011:** Rule H. Res. 194 passed House.
- **Apr 1, 2011:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 194. (consideration: CR H2239-2251)
- **Apr 1, 2011:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 1255 with 1 hour of general debate. Motion to recommit allowed. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments. The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill.
- **Apr 1, 2011:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 1255.
- **Apr 1, 2011:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H2248)
- **Apr 1, 2011:** Mr. Walz (MN) moved to recommit with instructions to House Administration. (consideration: CR H2248-2250; text: CR H2248)
- **Apr 1, 2011:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Walz (MN) motion to recommit with instructions. The instructions contained in the motion seek to require the bill to be reported back to the House with an amendment that strikes all after the enacting clause and inserts a new text entitled "PROHIBITION ON PAY DURING GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN"
- **Apr 1, 2011:** The previous question on the motion to recommit with instructions was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H2250)
- **Apr 1, 2011:** On motion to recommit with instructions Failed by the Yeas and Nays: 188 - 237 (Roll no. 223).

- **Mar 30, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 30, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Appropriations, and in addition to the Committees on Oversight and Government Reform, House Administration, and the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

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
