Summary (as of Apr 8, 2011)

Post 9/11 GI Bill Payment Restoration Act - Amends the Post-9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Improvements Act of 2010 to repeal a provision which reduces from eight to four weeks during any year the time between educational program enrollment periods during which Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) interval payments are authorized.

Rescinds from funds determined to be duplicative the amount required to implement this Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 29, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **Apr 8, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 8, 2011:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E676)
- **Apr 8, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Appropriations, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
