Summary (as of May 4, 2011)

Nuclear Used Fuel Prize Act of 2011 - Instructs the Secretary of Energy to implement a program to award cash prizes competitively for research, development, demonstration, and commercial application of nuclear used fuel storage.

Authorizes the Secretary to enter into an agreement with a private, nonprofit entity to administer the prize competition.

Actions Timeline

- **May 6, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Environment.
- **May 4, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **May 4, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee(s) concerned.
