Summary (as of Jun 16, 2011)

Child Trafficking Victims Protection Act - Directs the Secretary of Homeland Security (DHS) to require live training of all DHS personnel who come into contact with unaccompanied alien children.

Sets forth related protections for such children regarding: (1) prompt placement with the Office of Refugee Resettlement, (2) qualified resources at appropriate ports of entry, (3) confidentiality, and (4) access to counsel.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 25, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration Policy and Enforcement.
- **Jun 23, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security.
- **Jun 16, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 16, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
