Summary (as of Jun 24, 2011)

Renewable Energy for a Brighter Future Act - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow an electric utility: (1) a renewable electricity integration tax credit for the purchase or production of renewable power, or (2) a payment in lieu of such credit for sales of renewable electricity to retail customers.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 24, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 24, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 24, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Power.
