Summary (as of Apr 26, 2012)

Protect America's Cities from Government Blacklist Act of 2012 - Prohibits any federal agency or department from establishing or implementing an internal policy regarding travel, event, meeting, or conference locations that discourages or prohibits the selection of a location that is perceived to be a resort or vacation destination.
