### Summary (as of Jul 19, 2011)

Wasteful Presidential Coin Act of 2011 - Terminates the program for redesign and issuance of circulating \$1 coins honoring each of the Presidents of the United States (Presidential \$1 Coin Program).

Prohibits the minting or issuance of any \$1 coin during any period in which the number of \$1 coins issued, but not in circulation, is more than 10% of the number in circulation.
