112 HJRES 49	Related bill	Mar 15, 2011: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs.

Directs the President, pursuant to the War Powers Resolution, to remove the U.S. Armed Forces from Afghanistan: (1) by no later than 30 days after this resolution is adopted; or (2) if the President determines that it is not safe to remove them by such date, by no later than December 31, 2011, or such earlier date that the President determines that they can be safely removed.

- **Mar 17, 2011:** Considered pursuant to a previous order. (consideration: CR H1920-1953; text of measure as introduced: CR H1920)
- **Mar 17, 2011:** DEBATE - Pursuant to a previous special order, the House proceeded with 2 hours of debate on H. Con. Res. 28.
- **Mar 17, 2011:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule. (consideration: CR H1953)
- **Mar 17, 2011:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Con.Res. 28, the Chair put the question on adoption of the concurrent resolution and by voice vote announced the ayes had prevailed. Ms. Ros-Lehtinen demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption of the concurrent resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Mar 17, 2011:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H1967-1968)
- **Mar 17, 2011:** Failed of passage/not agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Failed by the Yeas and Nays: 93 - 321, 1 Present (Roll no. 193).
- **Mar 17, 2011:** On agreeing to the resolution Failed by the Yeas and Nays: 93 - 321, 1 Present (Roll no. 193).
