Summary (as of Sep 7, 2011)

Putting America Back to Work Act of 2011 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to extend the tax deduction for dividends received from a controlled foreign corporation that are reinvested in the United States.

Establishes in the Treasury the Jobs Trust Fund to fund infrastructure projects and improvements in the United States.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 8, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Aviation.
- **Sep 8, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit.
- **Sep 7, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 7, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Sep 7, 2011:** Referred for a period ending not later than September 7 2011, (or for a later time if the Chairman so designates) to the Subcommittee on Health, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the subcommittee concerned.
