Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2112) making appropriations for Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 14, 2011:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4096-4104)
- **Jun 14, 2011:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 300.
- **Jun 14, 2011:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H4104)
- **Jun 14, 2011:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 300, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution, and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 14, 2011:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H4107)
- **Jun 14, 2011:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 235 - 180 (Roll no. 419). (text: CR H4096-4097)
- **Jun 14, 2011:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 235 - 180 (Roll no. 419). (text: CR H4096-4097)
- **Jun 14, 2011:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 13, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 13, 2011:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The Chair of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in that portion of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose.
- **Jun 13, 2011:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-103, by Ms. Foxx.
- **Jun 13, 2011:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 45.
