### Summary (as of Sep 21, 2011)

Give Credit to Main Street Act of 2011 - Directs the Administrator of the Small Business Administration (SBA) to establish and carry out a program of making loans directly to small businesses in operation for at least two years. Limits loan amounts to the lesser of 10% of annual business revenues or \$500,000.
