Summary (as of Sep 22, 2011)

Access to Agricultural Labor Act of 2011 - Amends the Immigration and Nationality Act to include within the H-2A nonimmigrant visa category (temporary agricultural workers) an alien coming temporarily to the United States to work as a shepherd or dairy worker. Provides for a three-year initial period of admission with additional three-year extensions.
