Summary (as of Sep 23, 2011)

Amends the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 to require the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS), beginning in FY2013 and for each subsequent fiscal year, to allocate not less than 30 percent of the amount appropriated for the fiscal year for home energy grants to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Virgin Islands, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands to provide supplementary funds on the basis of need among such areas.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 18, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Training.
- **Sep 30, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Power.
- **Sep 23, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 23, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
