Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2021) to amend the Clean Air Act regarding air pollution from Outer Continental Shelf activities, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1249) to amend title 35, United States Code, to provide for patent reform.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 22, 2011:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. Nugent called up H.Res. 316 and asked for its immediate consideration. (consideration: CR H4378-4380)
- **Jun 22, 2011:** POINT OF ORDER - Mr. Garamendi raised a point of order against the provisions of H.Res. 316 by stating that it violates the Congressional Budget Act. The Chair announced that the disposition of the point of order would be resolved by the question of consideration of H.Res. 316. The House proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the point of order at the end of which the Chair will put the question on consideration.
- **Jun 22, 2011:** On question of consideration of the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 215 - 189, 1 Present (Roll No. 463). (consideration: CR H4380-4381)
- **Jun 22, 2011:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4381-4392)
- **Jun 22, 2011:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 316.
- **Jun 22, 2011:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by recorded vote: 230 - 184 (Roll no. 464). (consideration: CR H4391-4392)
- **Jun 22, 2011:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 239 - 186 (Roll no. 465).(text: CR H4378-4379)
- **Jun 22, 2011:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 239 - 186 (Roll no. 465). (text: CR H4378-4379)
