Summary (as of Dec 1, 2011)

Recognizes the hardships that people with disabilities must overcome every day.

Reaffirms support of the Architectural Barriers Act of 1968 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and pledges to continue to identify and remove the barriers that prevent equal access to federal government services.

Recommends that the United States Postal Service (USPS) and federal agencies install power-assisted doors to ensure equal access for all people.
