Direct M.D. Care Act of 2011 - Directs the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) to establish a program of pilot projects under part B (Supplementary Medical Insurance) of title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act under which the Secretary reimburses a qualified direct primary care medical home practice, using a monthly fee-based payment methodology.

Prohibits any pilot project from being established with respect to a medical home if the monthly fee for an enrolled individual exceeds \$100.

- **Nov 4, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 2, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 2, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
