Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1309) to extend the authorization of the national flood insurance program, to achieve reforms to improve the financial integrity and stability of the program, and to increase the role of private markets in the management of flood insurance risk.

Res. 340, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays, and the Chair postponed further proceedings on adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.

- **Jul 8, 2011:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 269 - 146 (Roll no. 533).(text: CR H4757)
