Partial Hospitalization Stabilization and Integrity Act of 2011 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) to establish: (1) a payment system for partial hospitalization services, and (2) quality service criteria to measure the performance of providers of such services.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 18, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 16, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 16, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
