### Summary (as of Nov 17, 2011)

Taxpayers' Cancer Research Funding Act of 2011 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow taxpayers to designate on their tax returns a \$5 contribution to the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund (\$10 for joint returns).

Establishes in the Treasury the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund to award grants for breast or prostate cancer research.

### Actions Timeline

- **Nov 18, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 17, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 17, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
