- **Jul 13, 2011:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H4962)
- **Jul 13, 2011:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 347, the Chair put the question on agreeing to the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Polis (CO) demanded a vote by the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on agreeing to the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Jul 13, 2011:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H4963)
- **Jul 13, 2011:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 250 - 171 (Roll no. 564).(text: CR H4958)
- **Jul 13, 2011:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 250 - 171 (Roll no. 564). (text: CR H4958)
- **Jul 13, 2011:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
